



The design pressure shall not be less than the value outlined in section 9.2 of ANSI/ ASHRAE 15 for the refrigerant used in the system.



Position angleway





Position straightway














For NRV CO2 valve(90bar), when the NRV is used together with GBC in parallel as a pressure relief valve, it is recommended to install the NRV above the GBC.

For the application use with R744 as part of a secondary loop or cascade system should refer to the datasheet for more attentions.
